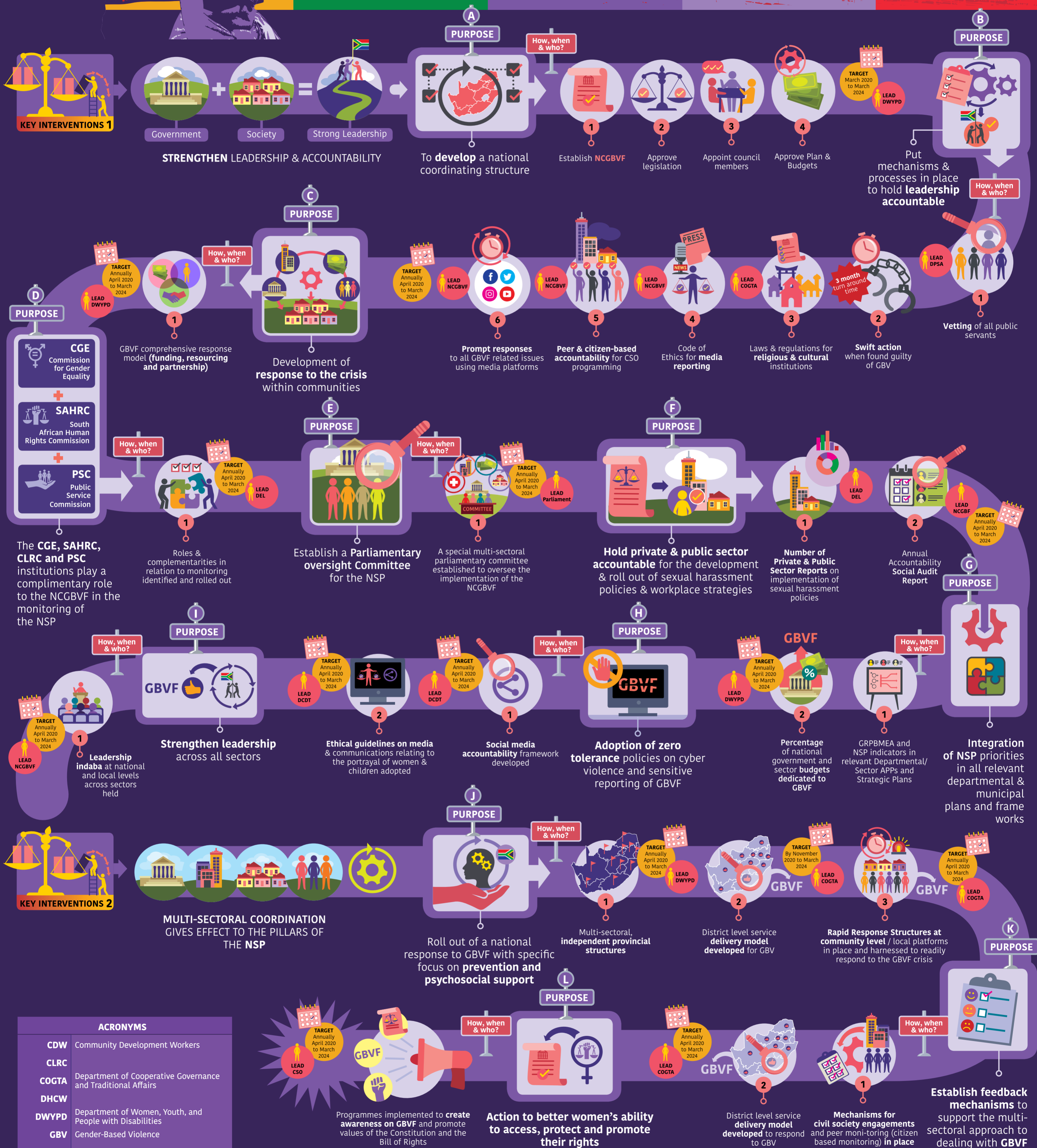

KEY INTERVENTIONS 1

Government + Society = Strong Leadership

STRENGTHEN LEADERSHIP & ACCOUNTABILITY

To develop a national coordinating structure

1. Establish NCGBFV 2. Approve legislation 3. Appoint council members 4. Approve Plan & Budgets

Put mechanisms & processes in place to hold leadership accountable

PURPOSE

CGE Commission for Gender Equality
SAHRC South African Human Rights Commission
PSC Public Service Commission

The CGE, SAHRC, CLRC and PSC institutions play a complimentary role to the NCGBFV in the monitoring of the NSP

1. GBVF comprehensive response model (funding, resourcing and partnership)

Development of response to the crisis within communities

1. Prompt responses to all GBVF related issues using media platforms

2. Peer & citizen-based accountability for CSO programming

3. Code of Ethics for media reporting

4. Laws & regulations for religious & cultural institutions

5. Swift action when found guilty of GBV

1. Vetting of all public servants

PURPOSE

1. Roles & complementarities in relation to monitoring identified and rolled out

Establish a Parliamentary oversight Committee for the NSP

1. A special multi-sectoral parliamentary committee established to oversee the implementation of the NCGBFV

Hold private & public sector accountable for the development & roll out of sexual harassment policies & workplace strategies

1. Number of Private & Public Sector Reports on implementation of sexual harassment policies

2. Annual Accountability Social Audit Report

PURPOSE

1. Leadership indaba at national and local levels across sectors held

Strengthen leadership across all sectors

2. Ethical guidelines on media & communications relating to the portrayal of women & children adopted

1. Social media accountability framework developed

Adoption of zero tolerance policies on cyber violence and sensitive reporting of GBVF

2. Percentage of national government and sector budgets dedicated to GBVF

1. GRPBMEA and NSP indicators in relevant Departmental/ Sector APPs and Strategic Plans

Integration of NSP priorities in all relevant departmental & municipal plans and frameworks

KEY INTERVENTIONS 2

MULTI-SECTORAL COORDINATION GIVES EFFECT TO THE PILLARS OF THE NSP

Roll out of a national response to GBVF with specific focus on prevention and psychosocial support

1. Multi-sectoral, independent provincial structures

2. District level service delivery model developed for GBV

3. Rapid Response Structures at community level / local platforms in place and harnessed to readily respond to the GBVF crisis
